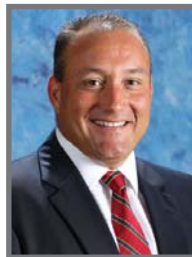

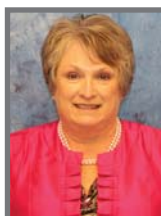

Spectator Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I help the players look for a ball?

Yes. Any and all help in looking for balls not easily seen is appreciated. A player has five minutes in which to find and identify a ball as his/hers. Conversation should be limited to what type of ball it is. Timing begins when the player has reached the area of search.

2. Can I carry items for the player?

Yes. Items like sweaters, and umbrellas can be carried for a player but once given to the player, the spectator needs to immediately leave the area.

3. How far away should a spectator be from the player?

Spectators shall be no closer than 30 yards from a player at any time (unless looking for a ball etc.) Spectators should never be in a fairway, bunker, or hazard, nor should they ever stand behind a player during his/her swing.

4. Where is the best place for a spectator to walk?

The most convenient place are golf cart paths (most are paved) which are usually out of the areas of play and remain relatively dry in inclement weather. Walk parallel to or in front and to the side of a player or behind a player provided that a safe distance is maintained at all times.

5. Can a spectator advise or coach the players?

No. A player may accept advice from their institutions designated high school head coach only. All other institutional representatives including assistant coaches are considered spectators. Spectators must observe the 30-yard rule in the fairways. If a player(s) is found in violation of the advice rule the team and/or individual player will be assessed a two-stroke penalty.

6. Can I bring a cell phone or other electronic device onto the golf course?

No. For all KHSAA postseason competition, voice communication devices (including all types of cell phones, two-way radios, and other devices) may not be turned on or used by a player, his/her side or caddie during any stipulated round or match.

For all KHSAA postseason competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a distance-measuring device that shall be capable of measuring distance only.

Rules for Coaches Giving Advice During Golf Competition

Note to USGA Rule 8: The *Committee* may, in the conditions of a team competition (Rule 33-1), permit each team to appoint one person, the high school coach, who may give *advice* to members of that team. The *Committee* may lay down conditions relating to the appointment and permitted conduct of such person, who must be identified to the *Committee* before giving *advice*.

Advice: Coaching Advice Rule: The Committee may, in the conditions of a team competition (Rule 33-1), permit each team to appoint a coach, who has met all KHSAA coaching requirements and who is appointed by the school and is listed within the school information on file with the KHSAA, who may give advice (including pointing out a line for putting) to members of that team. The Committee may establish conditions relating to the appointment and permitted conduct of that person, who must be identified to the Committee before giving advice.

- There are no conditions on conduct of a coach in this regard, other than requiring advice to be given in a private manner and requiring that the advice does not unduly delay play.

- **Coaches are prohibited from being on the putting greens and prohibits coaches from entering all hazards (other than to search for golf balls).**

A breach of this advice rule by any coach will result in a 2 stroke penalty **for the player**. For each additional breach by a coach, a 2 stroke penalty will be assessed to the player.

Please Note: Coaches may not use electronic measuring devices during competition of KHSAA regional, state or invitational tournaments. Penalty for breach of this rule is **DISQUALIFICATION** of player for which breach occurred.

Please Note: A player may have the line of play indicated to him by a coach, but he/she may not be positioned by the player on or close to the line **or an extension of the line** beyond the hole while the stroke is being made. Coaches (including their golf cart) are considered an outside agency and would not be penalized if their player's ball struck them on their cart.

Boys' Tournament Play

CUT: There will be a cut after the first day of play. The 12 teams with the lowest scores and the 20 individuals with the lowest scores will advance to the second round of play. All ties advance.

RULES: The rules of the USGA (with possible KHSAA modifications) will govern the competition. The Tournament Committee will determine the conditions under which play will be held.

FORMAT: Stroke play, 36 holes, 18 of which are to be played on Friday, October 8 and Saturday, October 9. In case of inclement weather, the champion will be determined after 18 holes, if the second round is canceled or not entirely completed.

- Team scores will be determined by taking the lowest 4 scores of the 5 player team for each round.

TIE BREAK: A tie for first place by a team or individual will be broken by a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff immediately upon completion of play.

- The best 4 of 5 scores with respect to par will determine the team playoff score.
- The individual playoff will precede the team playoff if both are required.

Girls' Tournament Play

CUT: There will be a cut after the first day of play. The 10 teams with the lowest scores and the 20 individuals with the lowest scores will advance to the second round of play. All ties advance.

RULES: The rules of the USGA (with possible KHSAA modifications) will govern the competition. The Tournament Committee will determine the conditions under which play will be held.

FORMAT: Stroke play, 36 holes, 18 of which are to be played on Tuesday, October 5 and Wednesday, October 6. In case of inclement weather, the champion will be determined after 18 holes, if the second round is canceled or not entirely completed.

- Team scores will be determined by taking the lowest 4 scores of the 5 player team for each round.

TIE BREAK: A tie for first place by a team or individual will be broken by a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff immediately upon completion of play.

- The best 4 of 5 scores with respect to par will determine the team playoff score.
- The individual playoff will precede the team playoff if both are required.
