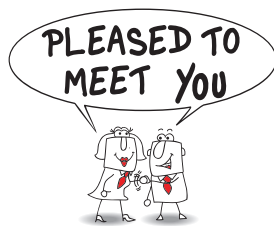

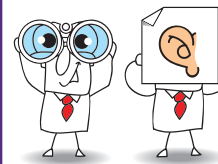


Draw or write about a time when you showed courtesy.
