I promise to no longer follow the leaders of laws of other countries.

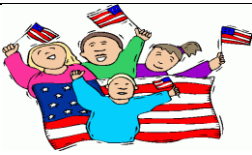


I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic

Constitution

The supreme law of the United States

I promise to follow the laws of the United States.



that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same;

Allegiance

Loyalty

I promise to be loyal to the United States.



that I will bear arms on behalf of the United States when required by the law;

Bear arms

To use a weapon to protect the United states

I promise to use a weapon to protect the United States if needed.



that I will perform noncombatant service in the Armed Forces of the United States when required by the law;

Noncombatant

To work in the US army without using a weapon

I promise to work in the US armed forces without using a weapon if needed.



that I will perform work of national importance under civilian direction when required by the law;

Work of national importance

To do important work (emergency, security, etc.)

I promise to do important work or help in a national emergency if needed.



and that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; so help me God.

Obligation

To do something because of a law or moral principle

I want to be a US citizen!
