

## Intruder Training Opportunity

On Saturday March 23, 2019 the Northern Lebanon School District is offering ALICE / Intruder training to all interested employees, contractors, and parents. The voluntary training will consist of a thorough presentation followed by demonstrations and active participation scenario training.

The presentation will be conducted in the High School Auditorium and will begin immediately following PowerPacks™ activities (around 10:00 AM). Parents are invited to attend the presentation portion of the exercise. Unfortunately, parent participation in the scenarios is not permitted. The training is expected to end by 3:00 PM

The training will be conducted by Mr. Reist, Middle School Principal; Dr. McNerney, Elementary Principal; Toriel Herman, Elementary Guidance; and Mike Koval, NLSO Police Officer. All four trainers are certified by the ALICE Institute.

The active participation scenario training is designed to apply mild stress to participants without being too intense or graphic. There will be no makeup or simulated casualties. It is suggested that participants wear long pants, footwear suitable for moderate activity, and a heavy long sleeve shirt or sweatshirt as instructors will be utilizing foam Airsoft™ pellets. Goggles or safety glasses will be provided.
