DEVOTIONAL QUESTIONS:

1. When you consider your journey with Jesus, what practices help keep it simple?
2. In what ways does the Kingdom's simple gospel keep your faith childlike, while you pursue big dreams and purposes?
3. Describe what you love most about Jesus when you meditate upon the fact that the foundation of your equipping is His delight in you, His covenant with you, and His supremacy over all things.
4. John 3:29 shows us that the friend of the Bridegroom (which is the church) waits and listens for the Bridegroom to speak. In what way is God showing you to speak less and listen more, so that your equipping is deep and divinely inspired?

NEXT STEPS:

1. What can and will you do this week to experience God's delight of you?

2. What are you doing to discover your purpose and calling, so you fulfill the good works that you were created for?

3. What will you do this week to progress in the process of your equipping?

4. Spend 10 minutes a day in silence listening to Jesus, and share with a friend what happens during that time.

*SMART GOALS:

- a. Specific - Can you state specifically what you are doing?

- b. Measurable - How can we measure this goal so we will know when you have reached it?

- c. Attainable - Is it within your capabilities and does it depend on you?

- d. Relevant - Do you care enough about this goal to make it a priority?

- e. Time Specific - It has a deadline.
