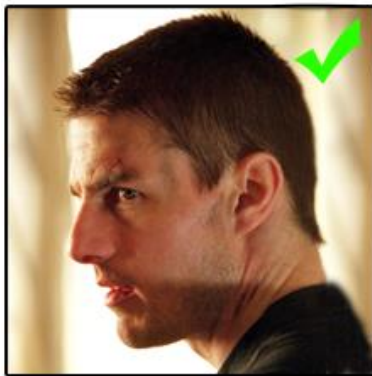
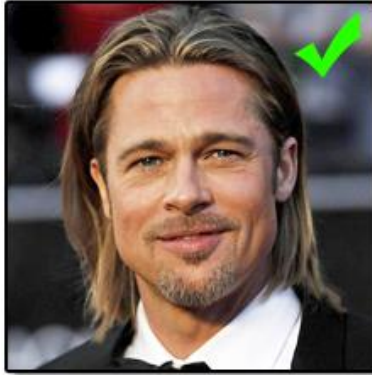


Photograph Submission Guidelines:

Please find below the submission instructions you need to follow in order to provide our expert artisans with the necessary photography assets so that they could accurately customize your bobblehead.

Front: Face Camera - Big Smile - Well Lit Area

The best thing is to take the photographs specifically for this purpose. Nice big smiles in a well-lit environment! Don't worry about going through all your snapshots looking for the photos where you think you look really cute! Take the photo from the front angle with the head straight - like a driver's license photo or mug shot. Get really close-up and make sure the lighting is good. While you may be tempted to turn your head to capture your "best angle," refrain, it's best for our purpose to see your face straight on. Don't forget to smile! Please note that you can't send us a photo of an unsmiling face and ask us to make the smile. We can't do that. Our artisans work quite literally from your photos and we will sculpt exactly what we see in your photo. 1 straight on shot is all we need for each subject. If you submit more than one, we will ask that you let us know which one to use.

A profile photo is a nice touch. Remember to keep the facial expression the same as your straight on shot. We can live without a profile shot but they sure are nice to have! The better we can visualize your faces, the better your miniature replica will be.

1. Facial, Hair & Body Characteristics:

If you have purchased a pre-made body and our artisans are simply sculpting your head(s), we need **ONLY ONE** of each of the following shots:

- Front detail shot of the head and face. **(REQUIRED)**
- Side detail shot of your right and left profiles. **(OPTIONAL)**
- Back detail shot of the head. **(OPTIONAL)**

This shot will be required if the back hair line/style is unique and/or you would like to bring it to our designer's attention so that it could be sculpted accordingly.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you provide more than one front picture, you will be asked to identify **ONLY ONE** direct front head shot you'd like our designers to base all the facial characteristics on. Please note that our sculptors will not be able to subjectively choose some gestures or facial characteristics from one picture and not from the other or even randomly combine them into one sculpture.

Please also note that once the design process is started, no additional pictures will be accepted as a reference.

2. Pose & Outfit Customization:

If you have purchased a fully customized bobblehead, you have the option of creating your own pose. Please let us know. If you plan on doing something more original, a pose photo is very helpful! For this purpose, we need at least one of each of the following shots:

- Front and back full body detail shots. If you find any photographs online that you would like us to use as examples during the sculpting process, please feel free to send them to us along with your Facial, Hair & Body detail shots.
- Photographs of the clothing, accessories and pose(s).

Please note that the better the quality of the photographs submitted, the better we can see the nuances of your face(s) and the more resemblance you will find in the face proofs. The bigger the resolution of the photograph (image file) the better.

All the photographs must be sent to CustomerService@MyCustomBobblehead.com. Once we receive all the photographic assets, we will review them and confirm that we have got everything our expert artisans need to sculpt your bobblehead(s).
