- 31 verses – covering 6 topics

- **Anger/Adultery**
- **Separation/Swearing**
- **Revenge and Relationships**



Jesus proposes a 'third way'



- ❑ Pharisees said 'follow the rules'
- ❑ Others wanted to ignore tradition
- ❑ We face similar challenges today:
- ❑ People dislike rules
- ❑ Some say 'no moral absolute's
- ❑ Situational ethics says...
- ❑ 'If it feels right, do it'



Jesus proposes a 'third way'



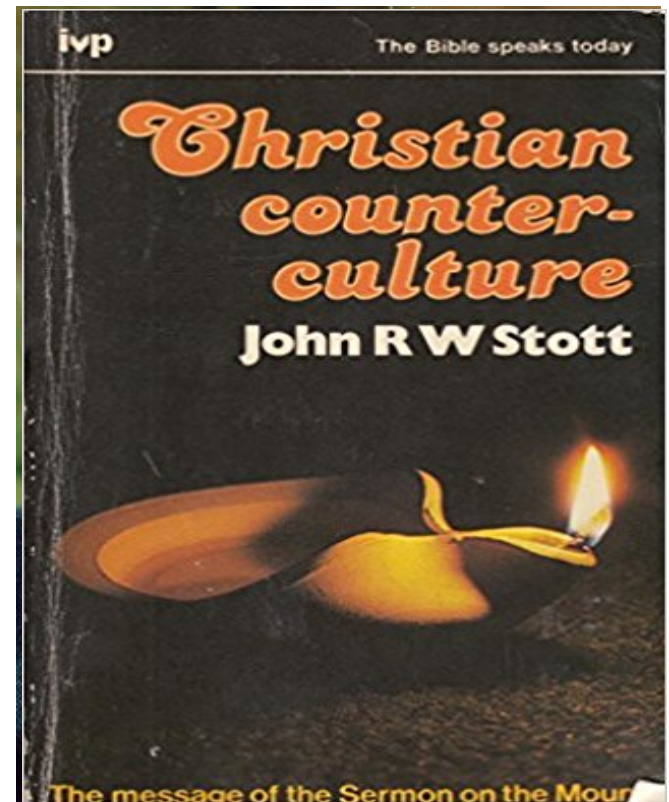
- He does **not** say we must follow the law
- He does **not** say we can ignore the law
- He tells us to **rise above the law** – and be even better!



- *'I haven't come to abolish the law, I have come to complete it'*
Matthew 5: 17
- *'Unless your righteousness is better than the Pharisees you will never enter the Kingdom of Heaven'* *Matthew 5:20*

Our problem is conformity!

“Probably the greatest tragedy of the church throughout its long and chequered history has been its constant tendency to conform to the prevailing culture instead of developing a Christian counter culture”

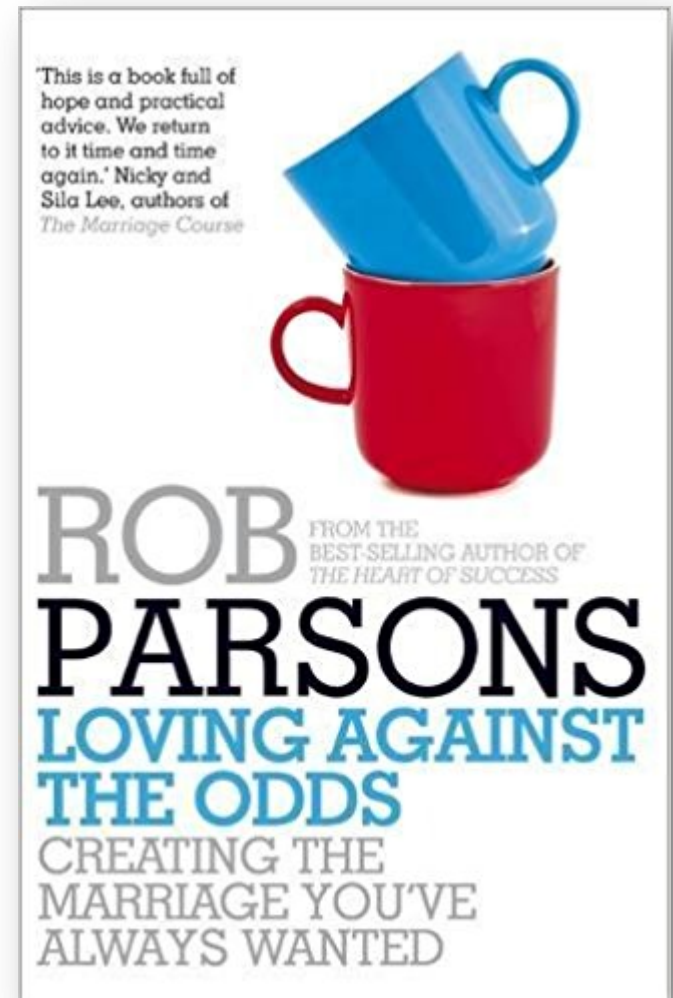
Adultery

- We live in a sex mad society
- Sex sells and its everywhere!
- Some talk about the 'pornification' of society



Sex was God's idea!

- Song of Songs rejoices in sexual pleasure
- But sexual thoughts need control
- Just looking lustfully is adultery –
Matthew 5:28
- David fell for Bathsheba
- 2 Samuel 11
- Christians need to discipline their thoughts
- Follow the 'ten second rule'



Separation and Divorce

- Two difficult verses (5:31,32)
- Marriage is permanent
- Divorce is only allowable if there is unfaithfulness
- If divorce *is* allowable, so is remarriage



So what should we do?

- ❑ Marriages fail for many reasons..
- ❑ ...with difficult consequences
- ❑ Jesus understands the pain and does not condemn
- ❑ Life isn't perfect
- ❑ Make every effort to reconcile



Love your enemies!

- Don't just love people who are like you
- Choose those you struggle with – and love them!
- Pray for those who are persecuted
- And pray for the persecutors!
