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## SAFETY

Don't shoot at hard surfaces or at a water surface as bbs could bounce or ricochet and hit someone or something you were not intending to hit. Always use high quality 6mm plastic bbs and never use already shot bbs, it might damage your airsoft gun. Always store this airsoft gun in a secure position, out of reach of children. Don't modify or alter your airsoft gun, attempt to modify the airsoft gun may make you airsoft gun unsafe to use and/or cause serious injury and/or void the warranty. - Take care of the feeding tube during barrel change to avoid to damage it.
- Do not untight too much the 4 barrel screw while changing the barrel, or you will damage the right stock panel.
- Do not overtight hopup screws or you will damage hopup rubber.
- In case of complete inner barrel disassembly, do not overtight lateral screws or you will damage the inner barrel.
- Do not prime the bolt while the safety is engaged or you will damage the trigger rod.
- For pull bolt, do not pull the trigger while the bolt is not not lock or you will damage the receiver.
- For push bolt, dot not lift the bolt handle while the gun is prime or you will damage the buttplate.
- Using the trigger preload at maximum will generate safety problems and probably slam-fire problems.
- Do not overload the magazine or you will damage magazine spring.
- Do not blank fire without barrel assembly or you will damage the receiver.
- Do not fire if barrel is not properly secure. We recommend 8 Nm torque on the 4 M6X16 screws.
- For storage, keep steel parts greasy to avoid rust.
- Do not use the gun without greasing the outside of the bolt (except the nozzle).
- Do not aply any grease/oil inside the hopup and/or the barrel.
- For push bolt, do not try to remove the buttplate if the bolt is in rear position.
- If you're using long knurled hopup screws, you have to remove them before to remove the barrel.
- Keep the bolt closed during barrel changes to ensure perfect bolt/barrel alignement.
- Be sure no bbs are remaining in the hopup and feeding tube before removing a barrel.

The Stealth Recon Scout A1 (SRS-A1) is the most versatile Sniper Rifle system in the world. It is nearly a foot shorter than conventional sniper rifles, maintains 1/2 MOA or better accuracy with DTM Ammunition, and can be easily adapted to individual mission requirements by changing the weapon's caliber and length. Whether a police sniper is shooting 50 yards or a military sniper is shooting a mile the SRS offers unrivaled flexibility in a package shorter than the M16 battle rifle.

#### Accuracy

The SRS achieves superb accuracy in all calibers because it's built around core accuracy components:

- 1. Match grade (free-floated) barrels, chambers, and crowns
- 2. High quality match trigger
- 3. Solid, repeating return-to-zero barrel mounting system (the receiver securely clamps around the first six inches of barrel)

#### **Quick Caliber Conversion**

The SRS is quickly convertible between the following calibers: .308 Winchester (22" and 26" barrels), .260 Remington, 6.5x47 Lapua, 7mm Winchester Short Mag, .300 Winchester Magnum, .338 Norma Magnum, and .338 Lapua Magnum. The caliber conversion and return to zero is simple and takes less than 60 seconds.



#### Rugged




The SRS maintains its accuracy and reliability in virtually any environment, including subzero arctic temperatures, extreme desert heat and dust, and wet jungle environments.






## ASSEMBLY

HOPUP (SRS Sport hopup is pre-install)





① Install the two hopup screws (M3x4) from the screw set bag. ⚠ If you're using long knurled hopup screws, you have to assembly the barrel inside the gun before to assembly hopup screws




Finely tune the hop up setting (flat hop up rubber as shown here). If hopup action is too strong, jamming could occur, and even stronger adjustment will damage the hopup rubber.

### BARREL (SRS Sport barrel is pre-install)






② Rotate and slide the barrel until the hopup fits onto the BB-tube.
▲ DO NOT APPLY EXCESSIVE FORCE ON THE BB-TUBE.




3 Set the barrel lock to «LOCK» position.



A Secure the barrel by tightening the 4 barrel screws, from bolt to muzzle side (and reverse order for removal).




While the trigger is pulled back, slide the bolt head, the cylinder assembly, the piston & spring inside the receiver.




3 While the trigger is still pulled back, insert the spring guide inside the spring, then push it into the receiver.




4 After pushing the spring guide inside the receiver, release the trigger and push it forward. Keep forward pressure on the trigger in order to lock the spring guide inside the receiver.




While the trigger is still pushed front, slide buttplate starting at the bottom and sliding up.






Make sure the tab is in the locked position (toward the receiver)








#### HOPUP


A SRS 20" Sport is comes with long knurled screws pre installed, allowing tooless adjustement. For SRS 16"/22"/26", you can also use these screws (from the screw set bag, please refer pages 6 & 7).




Case #1: too much hopup effect without side spin: loosen both hopup screws equally.

Case #2: too much hopup effect with right side-spin: loosen right side hopup screw.









Case #6: not enough hopup effect with left side-spin: tighten right side hopup screw.

Case #7: good hopup effect with left side-spin: tighten right side hopup screw, loosen left side hopup screw.

Case #8: too much hopup effect with left side-spin: loosen left side hopup screw.




#### TRIGGER BOX



To adjust the trigger position, loosen the M4x6 trigger screw. Slide the trigger forward or back to the desired position. Tighten the M4x6 trigger screw to lock the position of the trigger.




To adjust the trigger pull weight, tighten the M3x12 trigger screw to increase the pull weight. Loosen the M3x12 trigger screw to decrease the trigger pull weight.

**A** Excessive high trigger weight adjustment will disable safety use, and disable safe piston sear action.

#### CHEEKPAD




Loosen the two M5x6 screws.
Slide the cheekpad outward.




Adjust the cheekpad position (six positions allowed). Tighten the two M5x6 screws to lock the position of the cheekpad.

#### BUTTPLATE



While pressing the tab backwards, push the buttplate down to remove it. Using the end buttplate spacer (SRS214) is mandatory for pull bolt, and using at least one buttplate spacer is highly recommended. For push bolt SRS, make sure the bolt is in foward position before to remove the buttplate.




To remove a buttplate spacer, while pressing the tab backward, push the buttplate downward Repeat this to remove two layers.


A These operations are easier to proceed while the buttplate is engaged inside the stock.




1 Slide the safety button (right or left) to «S» position to engage the safety.





#### MAGAZINE




1 Insert 6 mm bbs inside the magazine (by hand or using a bb loader).


Magazine capacity: 30 bbs.



2 Insert the magazine firmly to ensure correct magazine retention.




3 To remove the magazine, pull the magazine down after depressing the right side magazine release button.




4 You can also remove the magazine using the left side magazine release button.






2 Move the bolt backward to compress the spring and lock the piston sear (until it clicks).




3 It is recommended that you pull the bolt by grabbing the bolt handle as close to the cyclinder as possible (to reduce friction and ease priming movement).



Push the bolt foward to engage a bb inside the hopup (you can visualy check inside the hopup if your magazine is empty).




5 Lock down the bolt handle to lock the bolt.

5 Lock down the bolt handle to lock the bolt.






#### MONOPOD (except SRS Sport)




1 To release the monopod, pull down on the monopod knob.



Profest adjustment, push up or down on the monopod foot, while holding the monopod knob.



3 For fine-tune adjustments, turn the monopod knob clockwise to add elevation and counter-clockwise to decrease elevation.



To return to original retracted position, push up on the monopod foot while holding the monopod knob downward.

## MAINTENANCE

#### GREASING/OILING

Bolt assembly does require regular, de-greasing, cleaning and re-greasing for optimal performance. We recommend you use a silicone based grease with PTFE as provided with your SRS replica. Steel parts need greasing to avoid rust which include: bolt assembly, QD sling attachment and magcatch. Avoid oiling or greasing at any time: nozzle, hop up, inner barrel, and the internals of the magazine. Doing so will affect accuracy and efficiency.

### CLEANING (BARREL/HOPUP)

Inner barrel and hop up unit must be perfectly clean to ensure optimum performances and accuracy, we suggest you to use a small cotton ball soaked in a non corrosive solution (alcohol or plastic/rubber friendly degreasing chemical) and push it through the inner barrel with a plastic road from muzzle to hop up. Repeat this operation with a new soaked cotton ball until this one remains clean. We advise you to perform this operation on this airsoft gun before first use.

#### STORAGE

After use, remove all the bbs from the magazine to relieve pressure on the magazine spring. Make sure the feeding tube is empty. If so, shoot in a safe direction to make sure the hopup chamber is empty. For long term storage, we recommend you to remove the bolt assembly from your replica to relieve pressure on hopup internal orings, ensuring long lasting air seal, and long lasting spring force (for pull bolt).
