

## Alberta Theatre Projects is holding General Auditions Monday February 27 & Wednesday March 1, 2017 in Calgary.

General Auditions are an opportunity for actors with previous theatre experience to introduce themselves and their work to the artistic team at Alberta Theatre Projects, and a chance for the artistic team at ATP to meet actors who are new to them.

We encourage actors from all cultures, races, ethnicities, and gender identities, mental and physical abilities to apply for a General Audition. Actors must be available to audition in Calgary. Sorry, no video submissions will be accepted.

We invite actors to prepare two contrasting monologues from the contemporary repertoire. At least one should be written by a Canadian playwright. Your audition must be no more than 5 minutes total in length.

## To apply for a General Audition please submit the following materials on or before February 13:

- A brief cover letter that expresses your interest in our work at ATP
- A current headshot photograph
- Your resume that outlines your theatre experience

Only those actors selected for a General Audition will be contacted to schedule an audition time. We will do our best to accommodate requests for certain times/dates if they are indicated in your submission.
